Area/Location	What to Donate	What NOT to Donate
Books/Music/Movies (2 nd floor, Fireside Room)	YES: Adult, teens, children's books. Music CDs and film DVDs.	NO: Self-recorded CDs, encyclopedias, textbooks, magazines, romance paperbacks
Clothing - Children's (lower level, annex)	YES: All sizes from newborn through size 12. Clean, without rips, stains, or tears.	NO: Torn, stained clothing. No teen clothing.
Clothing - Women's (lower level, classrooms)	YES: All sizes and types of women's clothing including undergarments, sleepwear, exercise wear, shoes, hats and accessories. Must be clean and good condition.	NO: Suits, shorts or capri pants (they just don't sell)
Clothing—Men's (lower level, annex)	YES: All sizes. Casual and leisure clothing--especially warm clothing. Jeans, shirts, sweaters, jackets, gloves, hats, outerwear, NEW socks or underwear in packaging, current ties. All kinds of shoes, sneakers and boots. Newer suits and sport coats (if the maker is out of business, please donate elsewhere). Everything must be clean and in good condition.	NO: Tee shirts with slogans, worn athletic wear, swimsuits (they just don't sell)
Jewelry (upper level, Fiatfalva Room)	YES: All jewelry, both costume and fine. Earrings, necklaces, bracelets, rings, brooches/pins, and watches (working or if they just need batteries.) Even single (orphan) earrings are welcome.	
Linens and Crafts (Balcony)	YES: Tablecloths, napkins, kitchen towels, bath towels, rugs, curtains, etc. Clean, without stains or rips.	NO: Custom-made drapes or any hardware

Sporting Goods (tent outside front door)	YES: If it can be used in a sport and is in good, working condition, it's welcome. Bike are very popular and can be repaired by an RRUUC volunteer.	
Toys and Baby Equipment (lower level, annex)	YES: Puzzles, games (all types), Lego, Duplo, blocks (esp. wood), dolls, doll houses, cars, action figures, stuffed animals (clean/new), craft kits (unused). Baby toys and equipment. Brand new/never used items!	NO: Small "happy meal" type toys, incomplete puzzles or games, broken, shabby, dirty items. Cannot accept car seats, crib bumpers, feeding pillows
White Elephant (sanctuary)	YES: All household items (small appliances, kitchenware, small electronics, decorative items [including holiday décor], luggage, hardware, personal care, office supplies, pet supplies). Clean and intact.	NO: Non-working, big, or outdated electronics
