

RRUUC SHELTER WEEK

March 19 - 24, 2023

During Shelter Week, the RRUUC congregation provides five days of meals (3 meals a day) for 35 women living at the Interfaith Works Women's Center, a Rockville homeless shelter run by Interfaith Works.

- Interfaith Works is a non-profit coalition of more than 165 diverse congregations working together to help the poor and homeless in Montgomery County (iworksmc.org).
- The Rockville shelter connects its residents with housing, health care, and social services to promote self-sufficiency.

What can I do?

- Provide parts of a dinner (main course, hot vegetables, pre-packaged bags of salad, bread, dessert) or breakfast food, fresh fruit, milk, etc.
- Donate items such as sugar, coffee, napkins, laundry detergent.
- Volunteer as a driver for one evening. You and another driver (each in your own car) will transport the food from RRUUC to the Shelter. (Leave church at 5 pm).

How do I sign up?

- On the RRUUC website, go to the Shelter Week webpage and click on the Sign-Up Genius link. You can also find the Sign-Up link in the eWeekly. It's in the paragraph about Shelter Week.

Who can help?

- People of all ages.
- SSL hours can be earned by youth who prepare food.
